### HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

### EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

INHALATION: REMOVE TO FRESH AIR.  
SKIN CONTACT: IN CASE OF IRRITATION, FLUSH WITH WATER.  
EYE CONTACT: FLUSH THOROUGHLY WITH WATER. IF IRRITATION PERSISTS, CALL A PHYSICIAN.

### FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD DATA
