SANITATION
 This is the first step and most important of any insect control program. Clean up all spilled food, garbage. Clean all surfaces. Scrub garbage cans so they do not give off odors (gasses) that attract insects.

DIRECTIONS

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Small Flying Moths, Fruit Flies. Close all windows and doors and direct fog upward at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Disperse in all locations. Keep area closed for 15 minutes.

MUD DAUBER AND WASP NESTS: Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 foot distance. These bees contacted will fly away from fog.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES, DRUG STORE BEETLES in exposed adult and larvae stages. Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, stored products, machinery, and dark secluded areas. For Carpet Beetles, treat infested area of carpets, localized areas of floors, baseboards, and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Spray 10 to 20 seconds per 1000 square feet of floor space. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear.

FLEAS in buildings. Close windows and doors. Hold aerosol 36" above floor and direct fog toward floor. Direct fog toward walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 square feet, making sure that all floor, wall and chair surfaces are contacted. Repeat treatments after 7 days.

ROACHES, SPIDERS, TERMITES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS: Hold aerosol close to cracks and crevices, directly into them, contacting as many insects as possible. Apply freely in all pest infested places behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, coffee makers, metal water heaters. Repeat all treatments as necessary.

CRACK AND CREVICE APPLICATION

For direct spray into cracks and crevices, use Whitmore Crack and Crevice Equipment.

DISPOSAL: Empty container; empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
