What is a true exposure? A true exposure is defined as close contact (within 6 feet) of a CONFIRMED COVID-19 case for at least 10 minutes, starting from 48 hours before illness onset until person is isolated, or direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case without the use of proper PPE.

Quarantine= Keeps someone who was in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 away from others by staying home.

Isolation= Keeps someone who is sick or asymptomatic who tested positive for COVID-19 away from all others, even in their own home.
