CRRSA Final Spending by Category

Multiyear **\$48.4** Million Award Expenses

- Learning \$8.7m: including \$3.8m in salaries & benefits, \$618k for Fine Arts, \$631k for contract services, \$445k for field trips, and \$3.2m for instructional supplies
- Social Emotional \$23.6m: \$19.8m in salaries & benefits, \$3.8m in non-staff including \$267k in CRE supplies and training, and \$3.5m in contract services
- Health Services \$0.5m: for temperature taking devices and student dental & hygiene kits
- Human Resources \$0.9m: \$792k in TA retention stipends and \$150k for contract services

- Facilities \$1.5m: including \$534k in salaries & benefits and \$933k for air purifiers and the Grant Middle School auditorium renovation.
- **Technology** \$5.3m: for student technology and replacement devices
- **Security** \$2.8m: including \$2.2m in salaries & benefits and \$586k for security supplies and x-ray scanners
- Indirect Up to 13.1% allowed for General Fund administration; \$5.1m

Continuation of CRRSA Initiatives

Non-staff items shifted to ARPA for 2023-24

- \$340k for community-based organizations for mental health services
- \$259k for diversity, equity and belonging
- \$250k for Special Patrol Officers
- \$200k for student dental and hygiene kits
- \$193k in supplies for reading intervention
- \$123k in contracts for English Language Learner literacy

Spent Remaining

District exceeded State required minimum spend of 12.5% in Y1, 18.75% in Y2, and 18.75% in Y3 of \$13.6m, \$20.4m, and \$20.4m, respectively.



State imposed requirements are not upheld by Federal Guidance, however, in an abundance of caution, the District will monitor these State requirements
