Dear Webster Wolves Families,

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year at Webster Elementary School. The Syracuse City School District is working with all schools planning for a safe opening of school. Our priority will continue to be focused on providing a safe, academic, social and emotional learning environment for our students. We appreciate your patience and all that you continue to do to support your child.

The Syracuse City School District's reopening plan for all schools is the hybrid model. Students will either be assigned Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday to attend for in-person learning. The other days of the week will be remote learning. There will be both online and paper learning options. If you selected remote learning at home for your children for all five days of the week, there will be detailed lessons to support the students at home. Please be expecting a very important letter outlining how your child(ren) will be learning at school and at home and which in-person days your child will be attending in-person school.

Here are some other updates and reminders:

- The first day of school for your child will be **Monday, September 14th**.
- **The school day at Webster has been changed to 8:00 A.M. – 2:00 P.M.**

As we are continuing to follow the CDC (Center for Disease Control) Guidelines for the safe reopening of school due to COVID 19, the following are some school wide expectations that we will adhere to at Webster School:

- Parents/Guardians will NOT be allowed entry into the building. Staff will greet your child and escort them to their classrooms. Pre-K Families will have a location to drop their children off and a staff member will greet them and take them to class.
- All students and families are expected to wear masks on school grounds at all times.
- All families must practice social distancing from other families on school grounds.
- All students will have their temperatures taken before they enter the building.

Address Changes

- Please remember to provide the school with a proof of address if your address has changed. If your address did change and you have not requested a change of address, your child's busing may take five to ten days to go into effect. If your phone number has changed or changes during the year please contact the main office. This information is very important if you are eligible for busing.

Transportation Information

- If your child needs to be picked up or dropped off at a location other than your home address, please complete a "Transportation Childcare/Special Request Form". This form can be found on the Syracuse City School District website on the "Transportation" page.
