- » Safety certified: industry safety certification completed prior to internships (OSHA 10, bloodborne pathogens, First Aid/ CPR, FEMA, etc.)
- » Dressed for success: with business casual attire and personal protective equipment (PPE) (provided by school)
- » On track at school: meeting academic requirements of their CTE program and academic subjects
- » Have transportation: to and from the host organization provided by SCSD
