There is no cost to attend Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps Pathway.

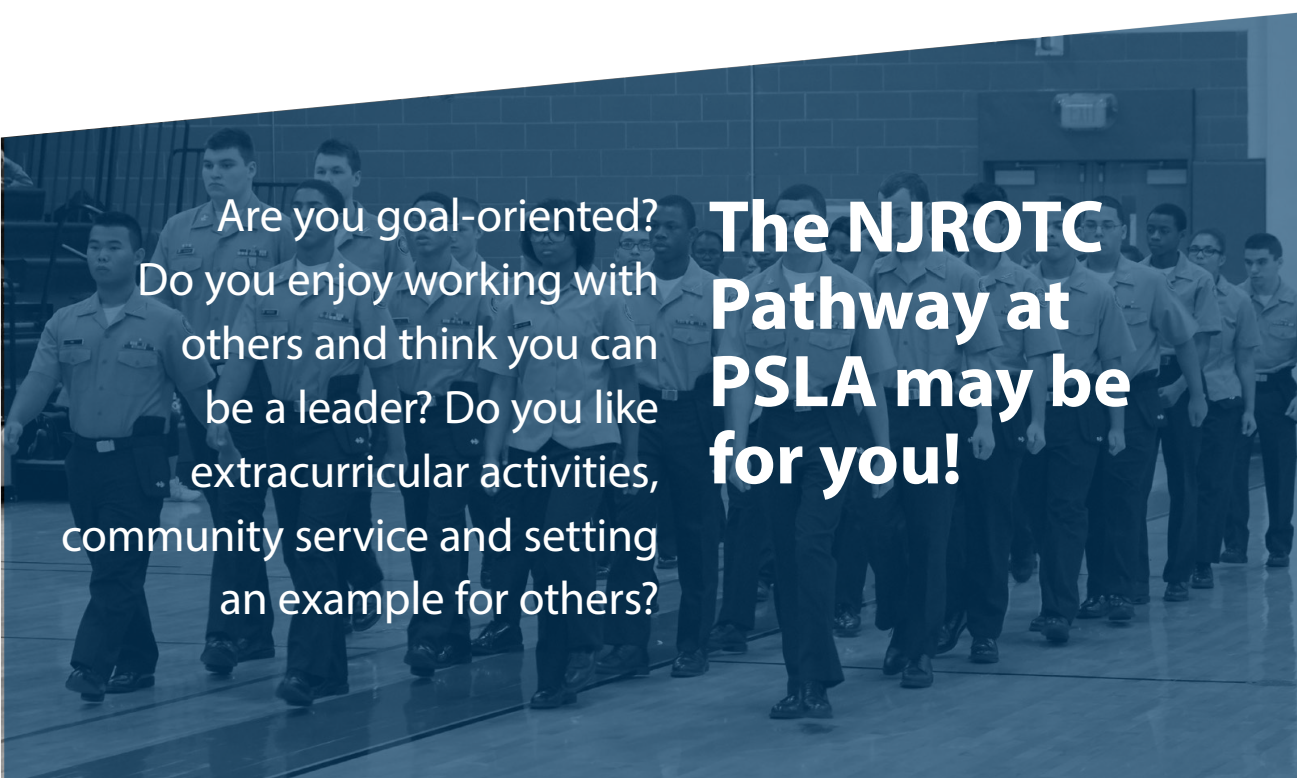
Where
