The Program: The Pre-Apprenticeship Program at Corcoran will prepare students to be first in line for a Registered Apprenticeship as an Industrial Manufacturing Technician. Students receive on the job training in the manufacturing field of their choice coupled with classroom instruction.

Students will receive assistance in matching up their interests and skills to a specific manufacturing career. They will learn basic technical and career readiness skills that will prepare them for full apprenticeship. Students will participate in a variety of work-based learning activities that include:
