The Program: The Urban Teacher Prep Pathway at Corcoran provides students with the opportunity to prepare for a career in urban education and earn no-cost transferable college credits. Students in the program will learn about and practice the unique skills required to be a successful educator in a diverse urban environment. They will develop an understanding of teaching and learning through hands-on lessons, work-based experiences, and specialized coursework.

Urban Teacher Prep graduates will have a head start for the next phase of their career in urban education from two-year college programs to four-year college and graduate programs.
