#### SCSD CTE Students Out in the Field

One hundred thirty two SCSD students attended the **6**<sup>th</sup> **Annual Manufacturing Careers Day** on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> at Lockheed Martin. Students toured Lockheed Martin and observed presentations by other local employers set up at stations throughout the tour. The event provided an opportunity for our students to experience and learn about careers in advanced manufacturing and engineering. Students participated in hands-on engineering projects and had opportunities to meet and talk with working professionals.

On October 15<sup>th</sup> SCSD students attended the **9<sup>th</sup> Annual Construction Career Day** at the NYS Fairgrounds. Students moved through hands on demonstrations where they were able to bend conduit, lay block, manipulate safety fall protection equipment and use general power tools. Opportunities were available for all students to try their hand

at operating some heavy equipment. Students were able to determine safety procedures necessary before you dig through the hands on demonstration at 811 Dig It. A variety of career and continuing education vendors including local union representatives and college representatives were also available to speak to students.

Once a month, throughout the school year SCSD students enrolled in the Medical Assisting and Health Professions CTE program will attend the **CHOICES (C**rouse **H**ospital **O**ffers Innovative **C**areer **E**xplorations for **S**tudents) program at Crouse Hospital. This program offers a series of monthly programs about a variety of health care careers including Nursing, Radiology, Oncology, Pathology and more. The program meets one evening a month from October through April and consists of a presentation by a medical professional followed by a question and answer period.

Henninger students in the Medical Assisting, Health Professions and Project Lead the Way Biomedical Science class also attend the "MEDS" – Medical Education for Diverse Students at UPSTATE. MEDS this year has connected with the programs at Henninger for a series of one-day workshops. ## NYSED Certification Office – Syracuse City School District Emerging Career Fields Certification Titles: UPDATE

We continue to make progress to the creation of a certification title for our four new Career and Technical Education pathway programs (Cybersecurity, Computer Forensics, Geospatial Technology and Forensics Science.) During a third follow up meeting, the NYSED Certification Office requested that Syracuse City School District also create a Career Path Guidance Documentation for NYSED Certification. As it stands now, NYSED Certification has all of the information and hopefully will create the title for certification soon. As a byproduct of all of the conversations with NYSED Certification, SCSD has been asked to join a study group at the state level to look a possible revisions to all CTE Certification Titles in line with our current submitted model.

#### **Career and Technical Education Internship Handbook**

We are continuing our efforts on the Career and Technical Education Internship Handbook. After a review of internship programs locally and nationally, we are in the process of working on a guidance document for employers, students, and our CTE programs. We will start cycling out draft copies of the three components in late November with a final draft presented for review in December. We are looking forward to the Partnership Council's input on the document.
