Technology Conditions Survey (TCS) Findings

The June 9, 2016 TCS Report included the following district-wide recommendations based on the observed current technology conditions:

Establish a redundant Data Center and Network Operations Center (NOC) to eliminate the single point-of-failure that currently exists.

Once completed, this facility will become the new Primary Data Center; the existing Data Center will then be used as the Redundant Data Center.

Recap of Related Previously Submitted SSIPs

This SSIP2.2 Executive Summary describes the second of two phases required to meet District Goal 2, Data Center Improvements:

- SSIP2.1, Primary Data Center Improvements - Network Operations Center (NOC) Back-up Generator, was approved by the Board in May 2016 and by SED in July 2017 for \$350,000 of SSBA funding.
- **SSIP2.2, New Primary Data Center,** the subject of this Executive Summary, is requesting \$6,576,426 of SSBA funds.
