Advocating for your Children— Skills to be Effective:

Know your child:

We may need to remind ourselves and others of our children's strengths and positive qualities.

Know your rights:

To information and due process.

Know the culture:

Keep Records:

Of telephone calls notes progress reports, report cards, and other documents.



In a meeting about your child:

- Listen carefully, and focus
- Ask questions, and state your expectations
- Clearly state your ideas, and make sure you have a clear understanding of any decisions.

- Check homework!!
- Seek help of counselors or other community resources when needed.

Here are two simple things you can do to help your child grow up healthy and prepared,

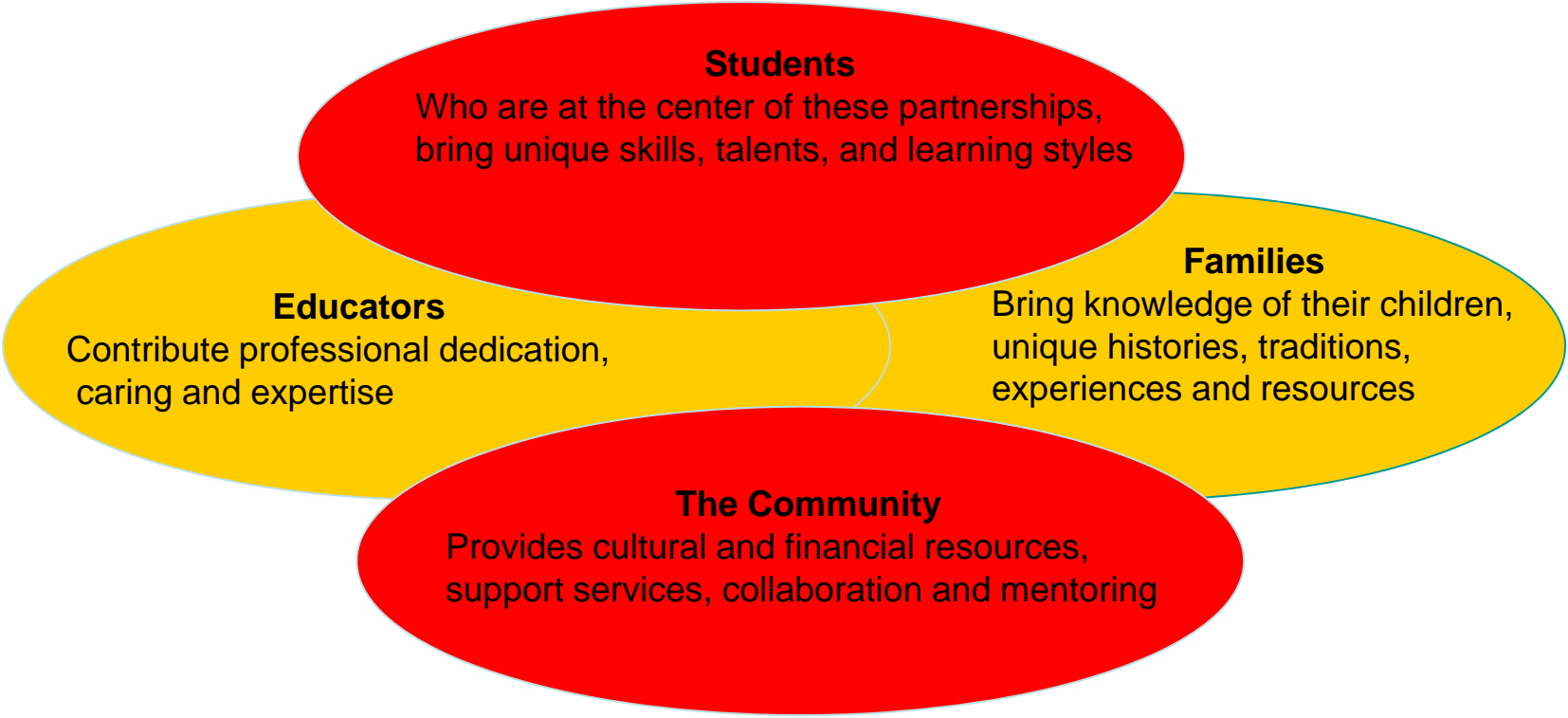
- Ensure that students are in school every day and ready to learn
