



Examples of Medicaid Fraud:

- Billing for medical services not actually performed.
- Providing unnecessary services.
- Billing for more expensive services.
- Billing for services separately that should legitimately be one billing.
- Billing more than once for the same medical service.
- Dispensing generic drugs but billing for brand-name drugs.
- Giving or accepting something of value (cash, gifts, services) in return for medical services, i.e., kickbacks.
- Falsifying cost reports.

Or when someone:

- Lies about their eligibility
- Lies about their medical condition
- Forges prescriptions
- Loans their Medicaid card to others
