





If the District receives more applications for this program than there are seats available (60), we will conduct a lottery using the Smartchoice Online Lottery System.

On or before June 15 (date is subject to change)


The Department of Student Registration will notify families with the results of the lottery; if your child has a seat at the Montessori School at Lemoyne or was placed on the waitlist. Parents/guardians will not be required to confirm acceptance of their seats. Students who are accepted in the lottery will be automatically assigned to the school. Parents/Guardians will be required to decline the seat via correspondence with the Department of Student Registration on or before June 21, 2023.

Transportation & After-School Programming



- Yellow bus transportation will be provided for students who live more than 1 mile from school
- Students MUST be 3 years old to ride a bus
- After-School program available for all students, 3 - 5 PM on site
