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Dear Families:

In the Syracuse City School District, we are seeing academic success and progress. Just this past month, another six schools were added to the list of "schools in good standing" under the federal accountability system. Eight schools were removed from the state's "struggling schools" list, and one was removed from the "persistently struggling schools" list. Despite this recent improvement, the SCSD remains a "focus" district and the New York State Education Department has designated your child's school a "priority" school for 2016-17.

The State Education Department rates each school and district yearly to determine its status. Focus schools and districts are designated as such because of their low performance and lack of sufficient progress in English language arts and math, and/or low graduation rates, particularly for certain racial/ethnic groups, low-income students, English language learners and/or students with disabilities. Schools with a 2014-15 performance that places them among the lowest performing in the state for combined ELA and mathematics performance or graduation rates are identified as "priority" schools.

Each spring, the district conducts a school transfer process in accordance with its School Transfer Program and Policy. In addition, in accordance with federal law, all students enrolled in a focus school are offered the opportunity to request a transfer to a school that is in good standing. Transportation is also available in accordance with the existing Transportation Policy. Schools in good standing include:

### Selective Enrollment Schools:

- Expeditionary Learning Middle School (Grades 6)
- Institute of Technology (Grades 9)
- Public Service Leadership Academy (Grades 9-10)
- Syracuse Latin (Grades K and 3)

### Open Enrollment Schools:


- Delaware Primary (Dual Language, Grades K-2)
- Franklin Elementary School (Grades K-5)
- Huntington School (Grades K-8)
- Salem Hyde Elementary School (Grades K-5)

If you are interested in submitting an application for your child to attend any of the above referenced *Selective Enrollment Schools*, the application deadline has been extended through **April 15, 2016**. You will be required to submit an online application by visiting [www.enrollinsyracusecityschools.com](http://www.enrollinsyracusecityschools.com), and clicking on the appropriate selective enrollment school link. Please note that the Institute of Technology and the Public Service Leadership Academy applications can be found by clicking on the High School Choice button. All *Selective Enrollment* applications will be reviewed and considered based on program-specific criteria.

If you would like to transfer your child to any of the above referenced *Open Enrollment Schools*, you will be required to complete an online *Focus/Priority Transfer* application between **April 1, 2016 and April 30, 2016**. All *Focus/Priority Transfer* applications will be reviewed and considered.
