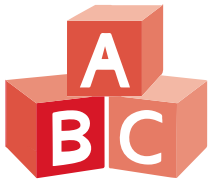

Required Documents

- 1. Proof of Address: Any 1 item accepted. Lease, deed or mortgage statement; Letter signed by landlord, owner, or tenant; Signed affidavit from someone proving your city of Syracuse address. *Other proof may be considered if none of the above can be provided.
- 2. Proof of Age: Certified birth certificate. *Other proof may be considered if the above cannot be provided.

- 3. Physical Exam: Physical exam record (signed by a physician or clinical staff).
- 4. Immunization Records: Up-to-date shots record. *If student is scheduled for shots, please provide proof of appointment.
- 5. Additional Records: Parents may be required to provide proof of custody and/or legal responsibility for child(ren).

*Non-Residents: If you are seeking to enroll your child, reside outside the City of Syracuse and are: (1) a SCSD Unit 1, 2 or 11 Employee, (2) Foster Parent or (3) temporarily residing outside the City of Syracuse, your home school may not appear on the School Lookup Tool. Please contact the Department of Student Registration, prior to completing the online registration form, should you have questions regarding your child's school assignment.
