<u>Odyssey of the Mind Presentation</u> - Mrs. Mosier, Instructional Coach and Ms. Darrohn, AIS Teacher (15-20min)

- Showed the video of the competition to the students and they were very excited.
- It's a problem solving competition that will happen locally, then across the state and eventually the world
- Problems to decide to solve as a team: Select a Fairy Tale and create a mockumentary about the Fairy Tale, use wood to make a structure to hold weight, or create a vehicle
- Looking for students who are willing to work as a team and have creativity
- Followed the national guidelines for auditions
- Auditions are next week (30 min total time), we will have one **team** of 7 students grades 3-5
- Dramatic performance (2 min) can make props and costumes but all has to be made, cannot just be purchased, needs to be made in some way
- Also- an improve section to the audition, they will be given a prop and they need to improve
- Spontaneous group problem solving activity (5-7 min)
- Need to send in the permission form- it's a HUGE responsibility, some weekends and nights involved
- Judges are going to be sent from outside of the school for auditions and will be choosing the members of the group
- The students are provided a budget and they have to purchase their own materials on their own with coaches or parents
- Parents and judges are there to guide students, they cannot suggest what to buy
- Mondays 8:15-9:00, Wed 3:15-4:00 are the practice days
- March 10<sup>th</sup> is the state competition in Binghamton
- First school in the District to have a team
