MS Goodman did a great job organizing the event for students to shop for items for their family. • We will have our School Incentive this Friday. Students will participate in a cookie decorating activity in the café. Students have been working toward this incentive and have been earning points for being Ready, Respectful, and Responsible. • We have had a minor increase in behaviors over the last couple of weeks. Actually had our first 2 referrals of the year for both schools take place today. WE are increasing our supports for our students and looking into our data to ensure that we are catching trends and trying to solve the problems before they escalate. • Teachers are using restorative circles to review expectations and discuss issues to mediate and eliminate the escalation of issues. • Hughes and Syracuse Latin were recognized as the school with the best attendance in the district for the month of November.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Even though we see a below the network average for 5th grade. WE have seen some great progress with those students who are working with our AIS teacher. Some of the students working with this teacher scored above the network on the standards they are working on. • The rest of our students are doing well. 3 and 4th grade students are 2nd in the network and our 2nd grade students were 1st. • Our 4th grade students are showing improvement across the standards and we have more students proficient in skills than we did for our state assessments. • Staff have been participating in PD around the ANET Assessments. The teachers were looking at the standards and the questions to determine the standards that were covered on the assessment. • Staff also looked at appropriate responses to the extended response.
