2020-2021 AMENDMENTS

Level 4 Behavior Concern, P. 22-29

Illegal behavior has been added to the Level 4 Behavior Concerns criteria. The revised criteria now reads, "Request for long-term or permanent suspension may be appropriate when behavior is illegal, presents an imminent threat of serious harm to the school community, or when the student's behavior seriously affects the safety of others in the school and/or educational process." (See Figure 1)

Behavior Violation: Attack on Student, P. 23

An attack on student with injury violation may now be considered a Level 4 behavior violation in addition to the previously listed Level 3. An injury is now defined as requiring that student sought or was advised by the school nurse, to seek medical attention and can provide documentation. (See Figure 2)

Glossary: Injury, P. 20

The term 'injury' has been added to the glossary. Its definition is "Sought or was advised by the school nurse, to seek medical attention and can provide documentation."
