Dear Rich:

Benjamin Moore & Co. is not aware of any correlation between the use of any of our coatings and an increase in absenteeism in schools.

Waterborne latex, acrylic and vinyl acrylic coatings manufactured by Benjamin Moore & Co. do not contain ingredients which under normal circumstances would be offensive. Since these coatings contain very little solvent, when applied following label directions, which includes adequate ventilation, any odors will be minimal and should not pose a health risk to the general population. In addition, any slight odor emitted will not be permanent.

Should specific circumstances dictate that no odor be present in an extremely short period of time, Benjamin Moore & Co.'s Pristine line should be used. Ready mixed colors in this line contain no solvents at all, and virtually all odors dissipate within a 15 minute time period following application.
