## **End of 2024-2025 School Year**

### **End of Year Calendar Items for ALL Students**

- Monday, June 16<sup>th</sup> – Last day of classes for grades 9-12, Marking Period 4 ends

### **Laptop Collection**

- Our laptop collection timeline is detailed below. Laptops will be collected back through ELA classes. Students should plan to have their chargers and laptops ready to return.

- Seniors (Grade 12) and P-TECH Students must return their laptops by June 12<sup>th</sup>. They may begin returning them starting June 1<sup>st</sup>

### June Regents Exams

- Below is the June Regents Exams schedule. Please check your student's schedule to see which exam(s) your student is scheduled for or please call our guidance office to speak with your student's counselor.
- There is **NO SCHOOL on all Regents days EXCEPT for Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup>** – all students will attend school and follow their regular schedule unless they are taking the Geometry Regents exam. We will run our regular Centro transportation.
- Transportation on Regents Days:
  - Centro will run at normal times in the morning for students to arrive on time for morning Regents exams and will run the normal pick-up time at dismissal (2:00PM).
  - The district will provide First Student buses to pick up students mid-day (11AM) at hub stops at specific locations throughout the city (these maps will be shared with students and posted online by quadrant; please look for these maps soon). Students who are finished with their morning Regents and do not have an afternoon Regents can take these buses to be dropped off at the hub stop locations. We will also provide bus passes to students who are leaving at times when there is not a bus available.
  - \*\*\*June 10<sup>th</sup> Regents Day will only run Centro buses. Students with an afternoon exam should plan on taking the morning Centro bus to arrive on time.
  - As we develop review sessions during Regents week, we will share with students via email and flyers; we will also post on social media.

### **Opening Days**

### **New Daily Class Schedule**

Dear Henninger Families,

The Syracuse City School District Athletic Department is excited to announce that we are now offering the convenience of online registration for all sports teams through FamilyID ([www.familyid.com](http://www.familyid.com)). FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our sports teams.

Before you begin the registration process your student-athlete must have a current physician's physical on file with their school nurse to participate in sports. If the physical is expired, you may submit a new one to the nurse's office by taking a picture or scanning a copy and uploading it to the FamilyID form or by bringing a copy to school.

Registration is easy and quick. To set up an account with FamilyID and register for your sport, please follow the instructions below.

## 1. CREATE ACCOUNT

### a. Visit FamilyID.com

- i. Type FamilyID.com into your address bar
- ii. Click on 'Get Started Now button'

### b. Fill out form and click Create Account

- i. Make sure you write down your password somewhere

### c. Activate account

- i. Check your email (if you don't see the email, check your spam or junk folders)
- ii. Click on link in email from FamilyID

## 2. FIND SYRACUSE CITY SCHOOLS

- i. Search for Syracuse City School District
- ii. The activation link in your email will bring you back to the FamilyID site where you will already be logged in
- iii. Type Syracuse City School District in the search box and click 'FIND'
- iv. Click on 'Syracuse City School District'

## 3. REGISTER FOR SPORTS TEAM

### a. Find your team and register!

- i. Scroll down until you see your team
- ii. Click on your team
- iii. Click on REGISTER NOW button
- iv. Fill out form
