Students participating in this program will engage in enrichment programming related to financial literacy, work readiness skills, mental health/social emotional behavior, self-care and health/wellness and career exploration. There is also a community service component which could include office work, grounds keeping and more. This is all a part of their enrichment experience and giving back to their school community.

Students must be in attendance for at least 75% of the summer program and complete all tasks and activities to receive the stipend. Hours are TBD based upon the school and program.

A violation of the SCSD Code of Conduct may result in your child not being eligible for the stipend.
