District Safety Action Plan Recommendations

Components of the District Safety Plan

District Wide Safety Action Plan Update

- 1. Continuation of the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) and training for all District staff and students, though a contract with the State University of New York, College at Oswego, to include the use of the Raptor Emergency Management Platform for drills
- 2. Introduction of and support for Special Patrol Officers at the middle school level, to provide a level of law enforcement support to students and staff for our students, through a memorandum of Understanding with SPD and the use of retirees for the role
- 3. Use of a newly crafted Pandemic Response Plan Annex to be included in the District Wide Emergency Response Plan, to maintain student and staff health and safety



Memorandum of Understanding

Adopted Changes to Commissioner's Regulation 155.17 Incorporate the requirements for adoption of an MOU into the requirements of the Districtwide Safety Plan

Section 32 of Part YYY of Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2019

Every school district or charter school that employs or contracts with: law enforcement or public or private security personnel, including school resource officers

- Must establish a written contract or memorandum of understanding (MOU) that delegates school discipline to school administration
- Must be adopted as part of the Districtwide School Safety Plan
- Effective July 1, 2019
