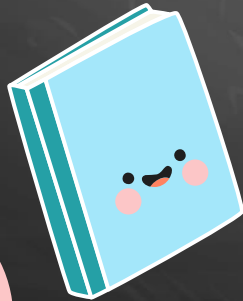

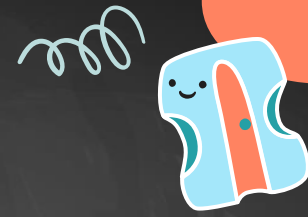

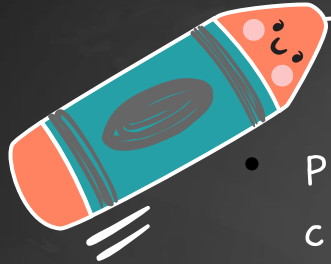

- ◉ If your child brings a lunch, please practice opening items with them

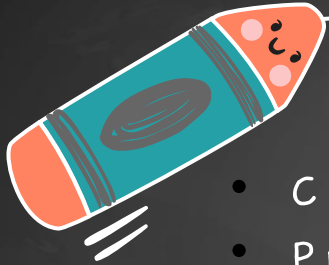


# Attendance Matters

Less than 90% attendance is considered Chronic Absenteeism.

|                             |                                       |  |
|-----------------------------|---------------------------------------|--|
| <b>95- 100% attendance</b>  | Best chance of success                | Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.                                     |
| <b>90- 95% attendance</b>   | At least 2 weeks of learning missed   | Satisfactory<br>Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.                               |
| <b>85- 90% attendance</b>   | At least 4 weeks of learning missed   | Your child may be at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work. |
| <b>80- 85% attendance</b>   | At least 5 ½ weeks of learning missed | Your child's poor attendance has a significant impact on learning.                                     |
| <b>Below 80% attendance</b> | At least 7½ weeks of learning missed  | Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education  |

# Attendance Matters



- Call the Main Office if your child will be absent
- Provide a written excuse upon your child's return
- Vacations and absences due to weather are not considered Excused Absences
- Review all of our attendance information in our Family Handbook
- Attendance is taken daily

# Strive for 95%

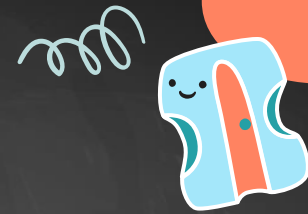


- Attendance Rate for September = 92.5

Living Environment – 79% Passed!



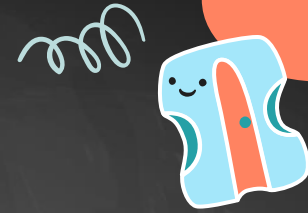
Algebra – 40% Passed!
