

CTE HS Students vs. HS Non CTE Students (HS Total# Shown as **Green**) 2016SY to 2024SY









2020SY to 2024SY (5 Year Average)










Average Days Absent



CTE HS Students vs. Non-CTE HS Students 2020SY to 2024SY






Average Daily Attendance


