VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Office of Onondaga County District Attorney

The Victim Assistance Program (VAP) of the Onondaga County District Attorney's Office provides help to victims and witnesses of crimes. VAP functions to see that victims and witnesses do not suffer unnecessary hardship as a result of a crime. VAP is also designed to help individuals and families deal with the traumas that result from a violent crime.

VAP can provide:

- Immediate general and emotional support services to victims and family members of crime
- Assistance to victims in filing for NYS Office of Victim Services Compensation when victims have medical, counseling, funeral, loss of support, loss of wages and/or court transportation costs
- Needs assessment with appropriate advocacy, information and referrals
- Information and reminders regarding court dates and other appointments
- Help in initiating the return of confiscated property
- Court accompaniment
- Updates on status of cases to victims
- Collection of information from victims for case files
