
ALWAYS Call 9-1-1 in an Emergency

What Is tip411?

The Syracuse City School District utilizes tip411, a popular tool that has been used successfully to help students protect their schools and reduce crime in over 1,500 communities across the U.S.

We know that people may sometimes be afraid to reach out with information, but when using tip411, the system removes all your identifying information and officers don't receive any information about you – not your name, not your phone number, not your address, nothing.

How Do I Use It?

1. Send Anonymous Text Tips

Send a text message to 847411, then type the keyword **SCSDDPS**, add a space, type your tip info, and hit send.

2. Submit Anonymous Tips Using FREE **Smartphone App**

Download free SCSD Tips app for iPhone/Android to submit tips tips from your phone or tablet.

3. Use Anonymous Web Tip Form on Your Computer
