Laptop Preparation

- 1. Use Chrome!
- 2. Open the SCSD Homepage, go to the top right, and click on search. Please enter library. Once on the library page, please see and open CLEVER.
- 3. Log into CLEVER using your SCSD computer username and password.
- 4. Click on the Canvas App.


Accepting Course Invitations

- 1. After logging into Canvas, look for course invites at the top of your **Dashboard** page.

Accessing Courses

- 1. Whenever you want to access a course, log into Canvas.
- Find the tile for the course you would like to access and click on the course title. If you do not see a course tile, click




Courses on the far-left navigation, then **All Courses**. Fill the star next to the course title to add to dashboard.
