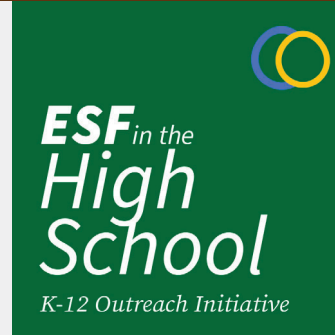


Curriculum Writing for Environmental Education
