

Overview

Together, all children in the class receive 50% of their instruction in Spanish and 50% in English. The program is specifically structured to develop children's oral language, reading, writing and selfawareness of language in both English and Spanish throughout the elementary grades.

As a result, children develop high levels of language and academic proficiency in all subject areas. The goal is to provide children with a strong foundation for growing literacy in both Spanish and English and to promote biliteracy and positive cross-cultural attitudes in our increasingly multilingual world.

Dual-Language Program

What is it?

Delaware Primary has "Two-Way Immersion," dual language classes where half the students are from Spanish-speaking homes and half are from English-speaking homes.

- Students who receive instruction in their native language during their elementary years have achieved higher academic success than their peers in other bilingual or ELL
