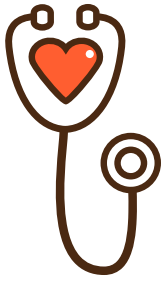


## Summer is the best time to complete your child's physical and update their immunizations!

### NYSED Required Physicals



- ✓ For new students to the district and pre-K, K, grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, those participating in sports and those acquiring working papers
- ✓ Sports and working paper physicals must be done within the 12 months prior to working paper request or the start date of sport tryouts
- ✓ In-school physicals will be provided by a licensed school medical provider for those students who do not have an updated required physical (In-school physicals, if missed, will not be rescheduled)
- ✓ Current physical for 2022-23 is any physical dated on or after Sept. 1, 2021.
- ✓ A completed physical EXAM FORM must be submitted. The form can be found at [www.syracusecityschools.com/Health](http://www.syracusecityschools.com/Health).

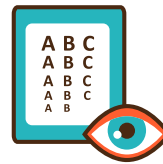
### Immunizations



- ✓ Update your child's immunizations at your child's yearly physical with their medical provider
- ✓ 2022-2023 NYSED mandatory immunization chart for NYS schools can be found on the SCSD Health Service webpage
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters recommended but not required
- ✓ In NYS there are no religious exemptions for required school vaccinations
- ✓ Medical immunization exceptions must be provided by a licensed NYS medical provider on a yearly basis

### NYSED Mandatory Health Screenings

(Will be done in school if not completed on physical exam)



- ✓ Vision:
  - Color, distance, near vision for newly enrolled students within 6 months of admission to school
  - Distance and near vision for grades K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 11 and when deemed necessary
- ✓ Hearing:
  - All new students within 6 months of admission, K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 11 and when deemed necessary
- ✓ Scoliosis:
  - Scoliosis screening for girls in grades 5 & 7 and boys in grade 9

### In-School Medications



- ✓ Must be carried to and from the school health office by an adult
- ✓ In-school medication must have a medical order indicating school day administration and instructions
- ✓ Must have written consent by the parent to give medication at school
- ✓ Medication must be in the original container
- ✓ Same rules apply for over-the-counter medications

### COVID-19 Protocols 2022-2023



- ✓ Good individual health and safety practices such as frequent hand washing and optional mask wearing
- ✓ Frequent cleaning and good ventilation will be in effect in our schools
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters recommended but not required

- ✓ All COVID-19 protocols may be subject to change
- ✓ If your child has COVID-19 symptoms, COVID-19 testing recommended



Please keep your child home if they have any of the following: a fever greater than 100.4° F, vomiting, diarrhea. A child with any of these symptoms will need to go home and remain home until all symptoms are gone for 24 hours. Always seek medical care if your child has a worsening illness.
