# Consistent, High-quality Resources: Demonstration Lessons and Plans

- Demonstration Teachers will be responsible for creating lesson PPTs, lesson plans, recording/filming lessons, and developing and support the weekly professional development for each week's lessons.
- Every Wednesday, teachers will receive new lessons and lesson plans as resources for instruction with students across SCSD.
- The SCSD Professional Development Center has also been staged with four recording studios in order to film lessons outside of the WCNY studio that still meet the required standards of quality for broadcasting.
