Program Information

The Computer Information Systems program provides students with the opportunity to learn the fundamentals of information processing, networks, hardware, software applications, and web publishing toward the goal of earning college credits and an Associate's degree in Computer Information Systems from Onondaga Community College.

Students will learn about common software packages for word processing, spreadsheets, databases, digital imagery and design, and desktop publishing and will use their skills to create authentic products for themselves and the community. Students will carry out computer and technical equipment maintenance and environmentally responsible hardware recycling.

Students will explore and apply the concepts of digital citizenship. Within this curriculum students will have the opportunity to earn Precision Computer Systems I Certification along with CTE Endorsement and college credits.

Students who successfully complete the Computer Information Systems pathway will be prepared for entry level careers or further education and training in programming, systems analysis, tech support, web development, software development and other opportunities in the computer information field.
